Dear Orchid Friends and Customers,

The Garden route is an area of many different weather patterns. Usually we have fairly consistent rain with a dry period mid-year. We have had 44mm rain so far this April and goods rains in February - maybe more will be on the way. My tanks are full at the nursery so I won't have to worry for a while.

My third heated bed is now up and running and ready for the new plants which have just arrived from Taiwan. Just a small order and the plants had a long journey to get to me. Hopefully they will root well with the little bit of heat from the beds. Can't afford to put it too high....

Bark is arriving every month by courier and I am still looking for someone to bring a bigger consignment from White River to George. The Rare Plant sale was fairly successful in December but not as good as the previous year. Thank heavens the organizers don't charge an entrance fee!

The plans for the National Show in September 2027 are ongoing and the dates 24 – 27 have been selected. Five societies will together host and run the show and the venue will be at the Stellenbosch Flying Club. Please pencil dates in your calendar – it will surely be an event not to be missed! Huge emphasis on indigenous orchids.

There are quite a few new plants available in this list – about 10 news ones from Taiwan and I have also added some mini-Phalaenopsis – species and hybrids – which are doing well in the heated beds. For me they are a delight and I love having them in the house to enjoy while they are blooming.

There are a few Phragmipediums on special at the end of the Phrag section – the list was much longer but they got sold as growers found out about them.

I am still only open to the public on a Wednesday morning from 10am – 1pm, otherwise by appointment. Address is 34 Napier Str, Blanco, George. I have been very popular this year with repotting on a Wednesday – at least it keeps Scott and I busy if there aren't lots of customers. I still do talks and only this morning gave a Phalaenopsis talk and demo to the Woman's Agricultural Association – what a lovely group of ladies!

O/o	<i>Ansellia africana</i> This genus has only 1 species commonly known as the 'leopard' orchid. From areas of summer rainfall, it can be grown mounted, in baskets or in pots.		195.00 Mounts R550.00 Hanging pots
TSG/	<i>Brassavola nodosa 'Panama Soiree'</i> Grow in pots or baskets, but they do very well also on mounts. They can carry 1-3 flowers per spike. Known as Lady of the Night orchid, highly perfumed in the evenings.		395.00
O/o	<i>Cattleya loddigesii x sib</i> Native to Brazil, Argentina and Paraguay. It is found in humid forests along medium-sized rivers and forests. Blooms in spring/early summer. Flowering size plants in 14cm Airpots.		495.00
